TWO YEARS OF WAR - SOLIDARITY WITH UKRAINE



24 February marks exactly two years since the Russian army invaded Ukraine and launched a full-scale war. Two years of indescribable bloodshed, material destruction and human suffering for the Ukrainian people, but also of brave, sustained resistance to the invasion.

Solidarity with the Ukrainian people's struggle for a democratic and independent Ukraine, free from Russian occupation and war, remains necessary. Peace and justice for Ukraine!

On 24 February, we will once again take to the streets. To support Ukrainian resistance to the invasion, but also to remember the victims. We would like to invite you to march with us.

We demand:

- The immediate withdrawal of all Russian troops from all of Ukraine and the cessation of Russian bombing and airstrikes. Solidarity with the Ukrainian people's resistance to the Russian invasion!
- The cancellation of Ukraine's foreign debt.
- The confiscation of the blocked financial assets of the Russian oligarchs and the Russian state. These funds should benefit Ukraine under democratic control of the Ukrainian people.
- Stop the transit of Russian LNG gas by Fluxys through the port of Zeebrugge. These
 exports finance the Russian war chest and crimes against the Ukrainian people.
- Increase the Belgian aid to Ukraine. Last year, Belgium gave barely more aid than the much smaller and poorer Latvia. In relation to Gross National Product, Belgium barely gave more than the Hungary of Viktor Orban.
